Although 2020 was filled with enormous challenges, POMDR has been fortunate to be in the position to help our community just when it needed us most.

Our Helping Paw Program was needed more than ever. The number of clients receiving financial assistance for veterinary care and pet food tripled

We were able to utilize our veterinary clinic to care for the dogs we rescued as well as to expand our services to provide veterinary care to low-income pet guardians.

Since our inception, POMDR has rescued a total of 2,540 dogs. We have also served 1,486 Helping Paw clients over the years.

Our goal for 2021 is to utilize our veterinary clinic to increase the number of dogs we are able to rescue and to continue to be here for senior and low-income pet guardians.

Programs & Accomplishments

Intakes

We took in a total of **340** dogs. 169 dogs came from guardians who could no longer care for them. 171 dogs came to us from shelters, freeing up space and resources so our rescue partners can help more animals in need.

Adoptions

Through our successful adoption program, **322** dogs found forever homes.

Helping Paw Program

We assisted **532** seniors, hospice patients and low-income pet guardians. Assistance included help with veterinary expenses, temporary foster care or boarding, dog walking, and transport to veterinary and grooming appointments.

Volunteers

Our team of **1,000** caring, enthusiastic volunteers provided foster care, transportation for dogs, home checks for fosters and adopters, follow-up calls to adopters, grant writing, help with social media, help at our veterinary clinic, and clerical help.

Perpetual Care Program

We now have **96** pet guardians signed up for our Perpetual Care Program. These pet guardians know their dogs are guaranteed a lifetime of loving care in a POMDR foster or adoptive home if needed.

Third Annual Lucky Dog Gala


Our March 12th Lucky Dog Gala was canceled due to the pandemic. Instead, we held an online auction and virtual paddle raise. We raised \$272,169.



17 dogs received hospice care in loving foster homes


