Key Points for Adopters/Fosters

1. **Flight Risk:** All dogs are flight risks during transitions. Be cautious with doors, cars, and yards. A determined or scared dog might escape even from fenced areas.
2. **Adjustment Period:** Follow the 3-3-3 rule:
 - 3 Days: The dog may feel overwhelmed and might not eat.
 - 3 Weeks: The dog will start adjusting.
 - 3 Months: The dog should be fully settled and comfortable.
3. **House Training:** Accidents can happen even with a house-trained dog. Supervise closely, establish a potty routine, and offer praise. Contact us for more details if needed.
